

We sold a 1/2 Timberline - 1/2 Wengler line gilt to a customer in Minnesota. They mated her to a Hampshire boar. From this litter a barrow was entered in the barrow show at a county fair in August of 1986. This barrow was champion at the show over all other breeds and crossbred barrows.

Another barrow, 100% Endow breeding, was sent in for carcass data. He cut .91 backfat, 7.21 inch loin eye, 31.70 inches in length at 230 pounds weight.

They are crossbreeding very well with market hogs and bringing premiums up to over \$3.00 per hundred weight sold on grade and yield. The Endow lines are the most tested Wattle hogs available, with over 3,000 market hogs sold by grade and yield by customers using Endow boars. The reports on boar performance are excellent, with boars being very active after 2 to 4 years of service.

I believe the Wattle hogs can contribute as much to the hog world as the exotic cattle have for the cattle industry.
